

## DVD Digital Snow with Mac OS X

**Step 1:** Copy from the DVD the file **digitalSnow Mac.sit** to your desktop and uncompress it. This will create a folder called **digitalSnow Mac**. Leave it on the desktop. Leave the DVD in the Mac.

**Step 2:** You need to download the file **digitalSnow1.1b\_osX.sit** [Patch] from this page:

Note : Since it's a "sit" file, you need to uncompress it with Stuffit Expander. If you don't have Stuffit please go to this page to download and install it :  
<https://www.stuffit.com/>

**Step 3:** Uncompress the 'sit' file (the name changes to **digitalSnow 1.1b\_osX**) and move this file inside the **digitalSnow Mac** folder you made in step 1.

**Step 4:** Double click on the file **digitalSnow 1.1b\_osX**. This should launch the Digital Snow main program.

**Step 5:** The first thing that happens is a message asking you to to install Acrobat Reader. Just say "no" (you certainly already have Acrobat Reader. If you don't have it, say "no" anyway because this function installs an old version of Acrobat Reader. You may try later to go to the adobe web site and install the latest version).

**Step 6:** The DVD should play now.
